**GOSPEL READING: – John 8:1-11**

The emphasis on newness from the first two readings today reaches a climax in Jesus' encounter with the woman caught in adultery. Jesus' response is typical, drawing out with razor sharpness what he considers core values in word and deed: holiness is found in compassion and understanding, reflecting the ways of God. There is no room here for judging others harshly while being lenient on oneself.

1. Are you comfortable with Jesus' treatment of the woman?
2. Who are you in the story: the woman, the Pharisees and scribes, or Jesus?
3. How does God's love sustain you even when you have sinned?
