GOSPEL REFLECTION: John 21:1-19

John wants to communicate one main message: "He is alive!" Instead of chiding the disciples for having returned to their former professions out of a sense of defeat, Jesus appears to them and joins them. Jesus' threefold questioning of Peter mirrors Peter's threefold denial, with Jesus initiating the forgiveness. What is the mood of the disciples at the beginning of this passage, what happens after they see Christ? How does this text suggest a new beginning for the disciples? For the world itself? What picture of Peter begins to emerge from this text, does he foresee the task ahead of him?

ST. MICHAEL'S PARISH – TRAMPING LAKE RENOVATIONS

Attention: Past and Present Tramping Lake Village and Community Residents

We are reaching out to you as former parishioners and on behalf of our families who hold deep roots in the village and community of Tramping Lake and St. Michaels Catholic church.

Over the past year we have seen a remarkable revitalization and superior transformation of the interior of St. Michaels church at a cost of approx. \$40,000.00 without assistance from the diocese given they provided financial for the contractor legal fees. The success of the project was as a result of the dedication, commitment, hard work, and time on the part of a very small group of local individuals. We are very grateful for what they have accomplished and would like to recognize and thank them for their efforts.

Recently we have learned that the church requires additional repairs estimated to cost between \$20,000.00 - \$30,000.00 and that the parish needs our help. While maintenance has already been conducted to address leaks etc. at a cost of approximately \$34,000.00, the steeple and foundation require further substantial work that cannot wait. The lift for this alone is anticipated to cost approximately \$6000.00/week rental fees.

Unfortunately, there are only a few individuals left in the community who are responsible for paying the church bills and covering the maintenance fees. They have given as much to the church projects as they can.

St. Michael's Church is an important piece of history for most of our families and was built by our ancestors. It is where many of our families were baptized, held sacraments, were married, held funerals and where church bazaars and showers were celebrated in the basement. It holds significant memories for most of us and we would like to see it remain intact for years to come.

Therefore, we are calling upon you to consider a donation of any amount to help raise funds for these final essential repairs and before additional damage can occur.
