GOSPEL READING – MATTHEW 20:1-16

What is a parable and what does it do? "A parable is a concise story that is drawn from life, which when told to a particular audience, makes one point that challenges accepted views." All of these elements are present in the story Jesus tells. What is the kingdom of heaven like? That is the basic question one must ask and the entire passage today provides the answer. The central point of the parable is not on the wages paid to each group but on the owner. He is generous and it is God's generosity that is the basic issue.

1. What is your reaction to this parable? Why?
2. How does this parable connect to the first reading?
3. Have we ever considered God to be acting unfairly toward us?

SCAM ALERT

Please be aware that fraudulent messages continue to circulate via 3-mail, as well as via text and message apps, allegedly coming from our priests, bishop, or others in the Catholic community, asking for money, gift cards, or other gifts. The message asks if you are busy, ask for a favour, or directly asks for iTunes gift cards or funds. Do NOT send gift cards, money, or cash transfers if requested to do so over e-mail or via text message. If you receive messages asking for help like this from our bishops or priests, either contact their offices directly to check whether they are authentic, or just ignore. If you are the victim of fraud, contact your local police or RCMP office.
