**GOSPEL REFLECTION: – LUKE 14:25-33**

Using a strong reactionary word like "hate" makes the point very clear: discipleship comes before family obligations and customs. The cost of discipleship is mind-boggling, an all-or-nothing deal, a life-long goal and relationship, based on ultimate trust in God's wisdom and providence. Jesus suggests that we consider the consequences of our "yes" to God: are we willing to go all the way?

3. How do you live differently in the world as a disciple of Jesus?
